What happens when we look at an art collection from a queer perspective? In the exhibition *(in) visible* explored this.

During the summer, you can experience three works from Malmö Art Museum's exhibition *(in) visible* at Malmö City Archives. It is Axel Karlsson Rixon's photo series *Tourism*, a digital work by Lena Mattsson, and porcelain objects by Matts Leiderstam.

The works are shown at the City Archives as part of the large exhibition that is taking place at Malmö Art Museum 12 Jun 2021 - 9 Jan 2022.

The Art Museum shows the largest part of the exhibition, which is based on the collection and presents works of art from the early 20th century to the present that raise questions about fragmentation, spaciousness, body and desire. The collection's gaps have been filled with deposits and new purchases. In collaboration with RFSL's archives and Malmö City Archives, various types of material are displayed that reflect LGBTQI+ stories connected to the city in one of the rooms in the exhibition.

The exhibition is part of Öppna Malmö - the city's work to raise issues of discrimination and racism, as well as WorldPride Malmö and Copenhagen 2021.

Breakfast for Everybody, 1997
Lena Mattsson

Lena Mattsson studied at the KV Konstskola in Gothenburg and Malmö Målarskola Forum, but she is best known for her video works and performance art. In the course of her career, she has also curated exhibitions and major film projects in collaboration with other celebrities, including Bo Cavefors and Ola Åstrand. Regardless of artistic medium, Mattsson's works often refer explicitly to art and film history.

In *Breakfast for Everybody*, she paraphrases Edouard Manet's painting *Déjeuner sur l'herbe* (*The Luncheon on the Grass*) from 1863. Mattsson has used Manet's painting as a starting point, a matrix, but altered the context and situation. The nude women in Manet's work are replaced with nude men, and the women are fully dressed. The camera in the video work is static, and the "painting" takes place in the front of it. In this way Mattsson challenges gender roles, norms and power structures in the past and present.

Under sommaren kan du uppleva tre verk ur Malmö Konstmuseums utställning *(in)visible* på Malmö Stadsarkiv. Det är Axel Karlsson Rixons fotoserie *Turism*, ett digitalt verk av Lena Mattsson, och porslinsobjekt av Matts Leiderstam.

Verken visas på Stadsarkivet som en del av den stora utställningen som pågår på Malmö Konstmuseum 12 jun 2021 - 9 jan 2022.

På Konstmuseet visas den större delen av utställningen som bygger på samlingen och presenterar konstverk från tidigt 1900-tal till nutid som väcker frågor om fragmentering, rumslighet, kropp och begär. Samlingens luckor har fyllts med inlån och nyinköp. I samarbete med RFSL:s arkiv och Malmö Stadsarkiv visas olika slags material som speglar hbtqi+-berättelser med koppling till staden i ett utav rummen i utställningen.

Utställningen är en del av Öppna Malmö - stadens arbete för att lyfta frågor om diskriminering och rasism, samt WorldPride Malmö och Köpenhamn 2021.

Lena Mattsson (*1966)
Breakfast for Everybody, 1997

Lena Mattsson är utbildad både på KV Konstskola i Göteborg och Malmö Målarskola Forum, men är främst känd för sina videoverk och performancekonst. Under sin karriär har hon även arbetat med att curaterat utställningar och större filmprojekt i samarbete med andra kulturpersonligheter, som Bo Cavefors och Ola Åstrand. I Mattssons verk, oavsett konstnärlig uttrycksform, återfinns ofta tydliga referenser till konst- och filmhistoria.

I verket *Breakfast for Everybody* refererar hon till Édouard Manets målning *Le Déjeuner sur l'herbe* (Frukost i det gröna) från 1863. Mattsson har använt Manets tavla som en utgångspunkt, en mall, men ändrat kontexten och förutsättningarna. De nakna kvinnorna i Manets verk blir i Mattssons verk nakna män, och istället är det kvinnorna som är påklädda. Kameran i videoverket är stillastående och "målningen" utspelar sig framför den. På så sätt ifrågasätter Mattsson könsroller, normer och maktförhållanden, både historiskt och i samtiden.

Lena Mattsson is a prize-winning Swedish artist. Her practice includes photography, performance, film, and video. Her new monograph, *The Window Open to the World*, covers her entire oeuvre, while focusing on recent works such as the piece about the legendary Swedish publisher Bo Cavefors. Featuring essays by Lars Gustaf Andersson, John Peter Nilsson, and Charlotte Wiberg.

What is beyond the surface? What is it that we actually see and what is only an interpretation of what we think we see based on our social and cultural references and personal experience? There is always something unneroving about Lena Mattsson's art. You think you know what you have seen but nevertheless you feel you have witnessed and experienced something else entirely. She is a master in playing with our perceptions and senses. She takes us to a place and introduces us to what often seems to be a simple situation, but which turns out to be something quite extraordinary. This duality and tension invest her works with a very exceptional quality.

Lena Mattsson (*1966) began her artistic career as a painter. Today, the Swede is known for her socially critical videos, performances, and mixed-media installations. Mattsson points out injustices, mistakes, and conflicts in our society. She identifies with those impacted and refers to her own experiences, actively including them in her works of art. This poetic, intimate interweaving of life and art lends unique expression to Mattsson's work. Mattsson provides no answers, but reserves for herself the right to supply the impetus to ask the right questions.

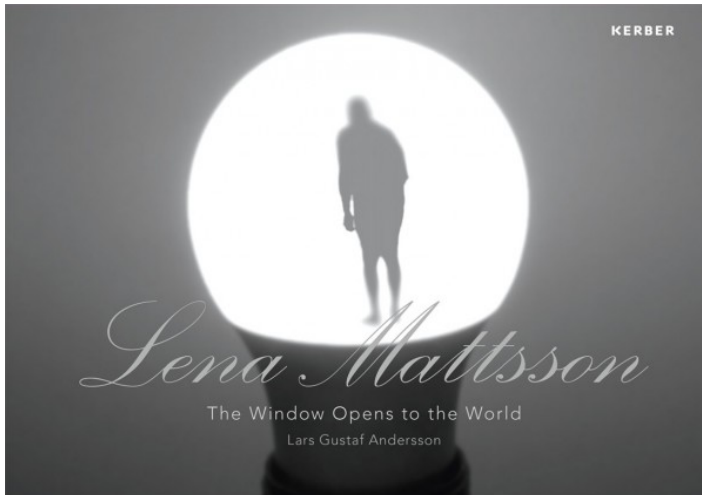
The newly released monograph [*The Window Opens to the World*](#) features her complex oeuvre as it developed over the past three decades, while focusing in particular on her most recent projects – such as the video essay *In the Eye of the Beholder* (2014), which is about the legendary Swedish publisher and author Bo Cavefors, or the historical exposure of the local punk scene in Malmö, *When Hades Bursts with Blooms* (2017), or the latest experiment with monumental video projections such as *Perception of Time and Space* (2019), which Mattsson presented at the Swedish festival Island of Light. Mattsson's works are an established component of many international shows and festivals. Her most recent solo shows in Sweden include *In the Eye of the Beholder* (2014) at the Moderna Museet Malmö and *A Small Fairytale* (2001/2002) at the Malmö Konsthall.

To capture movement is indeed one of the greatest challenges in visual art. Throughout the ages, artists have tried to do this in a variety of ways. Sometimes, it is a matter of capturing a fleeting moment with veritably scientific precision. At others, the situation is governed by inventiveness and a feel for the material. Sometimes, we see traces of the artist's movements, even though the work itself is static. The Swedish artist Birgit Broms was phenomenal at capturing movement in her pictures. In connection with the exhibition, we are presenting a rich array of works selected from the Museum's collection, where *In Motion* is the theme in various ways. Regardless of the tempo in the sequence, moving images are essential to the video works shown here. But motion is also a vital element in

watercolour technique. Pigments colour the spreading water. Together, they pursue their precarious voyage through the sheet of paper, blending, blossoming. The brush wanders over the empty surface, filling it with events and moods. The hand turns a page, and the story continues. The images are frozen, yet in motion.
